UGNEET-2026 – Admission to Medical and Dental Courses

SECOND ROUND SEAT ALLOTMENT – Provisional Results – Choice-4 – Final Results

Eligibility to participate:

Following types of candidates would be eligible to participate in the second round of seat allotment to UG Medical and Dental courses;

- (a) After first round UGNEET 2026 results, selected; Choice-2 or Choice-3 and
- (b) Those who have not been allotted any seat in the first round, further;
- (c) The candidates who have opted for Choice 4 in the UGCET 2nd Round Seat Allotment will also be considered; subject to the availability of Medical or Dental options in their options entry list.

Instructions on Option Entry:

- (a) **Option entry - from 2.00 pm on 07-09-2026 & concludes on 09-09-2026 –2.00 pm.**
- (b) Candidates should compulsorily log in to the login portal on or before the last date prescribed for entry of options for second round and prioritize the options, save and submit the options.
- (c) As the seats which may get cancelled /forfeited/newly added if any, will also be published from time to time, candidates are advised to keep checking the KEA Website for updates on the availability of seats.
- (d) Further, the seats will be considered for allotment as a result of any CONSEQUENTIAL VACANCY that may arise during the seat allotment. Therefore, candidates are advised to retain all the options they are interested in choosing irrespective of the seats shown in the seat matrix.
- (e) **Candidates are advised to preserve the print out of the finally submitted options.**

Virtual Vacancies:

- i. The seat held by CHOICE-2 of first round candidate will be displayed as virtual vacancy.
- ii. If any Choice-2 candidate of first round upgraded in the second round, vacates the first round seat.
- iii. That vacated seat will be offered to the next eligible candidate in this second round provided such options are available in the candidate option entry list. Hence, all the second round eligible candidates are advised to retain such options if they are interested.

Provisional Results: Date will be informed later.

For admission to Medical and Dental courses, 2nd round seat allotment has been conducted based on the merit and options entered by the candidates and the provisional results will be hosted on the KEA Website.

Choice-4 – Dates will be informed later to select Choice-4.

- a. If a candidate is not interested in the provisionally allotted seat or opted MCC seat / other states seat, he / she can choose Choice-4 and exit from this year UGNEET counseling process.
- b. Choice-4 candidates will not be permitted again for allotment of seats.

Publication of 2nd round seat allotment final results: Date will be informed later.

- a. In this way, all the Choice-04 seats will be consolidated; the 2nd round of seat allotment will be re-run (up-gradation) based on the already entered options, (no change in options will be allowed), and the final results will be published.
- b. Seat allotted candidates will have only **Choice-1** to select and Choice-4 will **not** be available. Candidates should compulsorily take admission in the allotted seat. If interested, they can participate in the third round by login. (as per the recent orders of the Hon'ble High Courts)
- c. Since Choice-4 was provided after provisional results, if any candidate fails to take admission by selecting Choice-1 after final results; such candidates will be restricted for further rounds and also recommend MCC to restrict.

Compulsory admission: Schedule will be informed later.

The candidates, who may be allotted seats in the final results, should pay the prescribed fees, download the seat confirmation slip; and invariably report to the allotted college as per schedule to be published.
